Great Alne Parish Council is seeking to co-opt a new Member to join our team. The term of office will last until the next elections in May 2027, when all Members must be re-elected.

Applications are invited from any parishioner who feels they could contribute to the working of Great Alne Parish Council and who is keen to be involved in shaping their community's future. No experience is necessary, and training is available.

A candidate for a parish or town council is qualified if, when nominated:

- he or she is a British citizen, a citizen of any member state of the European Union or an eligible Commonwealth citizen
- is over 18 years of age
- is either in the list of electors for that parish or town or has during the whole of the preceding twelve months:
 1. occupied land as owner or tenant in it; or
 2. had a principal place of work there; or
 3. resided in or within three miles of it.
- And is not disqualified from holding office as a Councillor.
